WORKGROUP INITIATIVES

- Continue implementation of the increase in annual training hours for licensed caregivers from 4 hours to 12 hours that takes effect for licenses renewed on or after January 1, 2017.
- Partner with DFS Licensing and the QPI Communications Workgroup to establish effective communication of the new licensing training requirements and to ensure availability of mandated first year trainings.
- Review and manage the QPI Just In Time Training site to make recommendations for training, changes, updates, and ongoing maintenance.
- Partner with all other QPI workgroups to develop trainings to assist with any changes in operating procedures.
- Continue work in the Training Sub-Workgroup in developing the assessment and restructuring of the curriculum for foster parent pre-service training.
- Develop training for transitions of children between placements that are child-focused.
